

SchoolTool Mobile Application: Getting Started

The Sackets Harbor Central School District is proud to announce that the **schooltool** mobile application is available for grades 6-12 on iOS and Android devices 4.0 and higher!

Students can log in to see information about current schedules, assignments, and attendance. Students will also be able to receive push notifications when assignment grades have been submitted.

To get started using the **schooltool** mobile app, you will need the website (URL) and the **Student Portal** account information provided by your district (see below).

Note: If you do not have **Student Portal** access, you will need to fill out the online Student Portal Application **OR** fill out the **Student Portal Application Form** and return it to the School Counseling Office. Please contact the School Counseling Office with any additional questions regarding your Student Portal account.

1. Download and install the **schooltool** mobile app (click on the images below to download from your device's app store).

2. Log in using the account information provided by your district (see below).

After installing and opening the **schooltool** mobile app, enter your **schooltool** credentials and click the Log in button.

The following fields are required:

- **schooltool URL:** Enter <https://schooltool.sacketspatriots.org/schooltoolweb>
- **Username:** Enter your network username.
- **Password:** Enter your network password.
